East or west on State Route 2. Take Exit 283 to State Route 44 south to SR 84 (Johnnycake Rd.), east to E. Walnut St., right onto Riverside Dr.

East on I-90. Take Exit 200 to State Route 44, north to State Route 84 (Johnnycake Rd.), east to E. Walnut St., right onto Riverside Dr.

West on I-90. Take Vrooman Rd. north to Route 84 (Riverside Dr.), left on Riverside Dr.
